## **OVERVIEW**

## **GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE**

As of January 31, 2019, the General Fund cash balance has an operating surplus of \$210.7 million. This is the result of a \$749.8 million beginning cash balance on July 1, 2018 and a \$539.1 million operating cash deficit for FY 2019.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2019.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$240.4 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund. It should be noted that the difference between the \$240.4 million and the net operating cash balance of \$210.7 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing of \$29.7 million, pursuant to §7404 (d), Title 29 Delaware Code.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance was \$2,140.6 million.

As required by Executive Order 21 approved on June 30, 2018, §1(d), for reporting and budget planning purposes only, \$152.6 million of the General Fund is allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund.
