#### **OVERVIEW**

#### GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

As of February 28, 2023, the General Fund cash balance has ending net operating cash of \$1,709.6 million. This is the result of a \$2,605.3 million beginning cash balance on July 1, 2022, a \$493.1 million operating cash deficit for FY 2023 and an allocation of \$402.6 million to the Budget Stabilization Fund.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2023.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$316.4 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance is \$6,000.6 million. Of this amount, \$730.5 million was received from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) and is included in the Special Fund Cash Balance. Unaudited ARP expenditures through February 28, 2023 are \$299.3 million recorded in the Special Fund. Of the \$299.3 million, \$100.9 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing.

The cash received for the Coronavirus Relief Fund in the amount of \$1,066.2 million was fully expended for program costs incurred by December 31, 2021 with final reporting of expenditures on January 31, 2023 and final transfer of funds from the Special Fund to the General Fund by February 28, 2023.

Effective July 1, 2022, pursuant to 83 Del. Law, c. 325 (SB 250, §71), \$402.6 million was allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund, a special fund holding account that would require an act of the General Assembly to enable appropriation and spending authority. As required by Executive Order 21 approved on June 30, 2018, §1(d), the Budget Stabilization Fund is increased by \$528.3 million, for reporting and planning purposes only.
