#### **OVERVIEW**

### **GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE**

As of March 31, 2019, the General Fund cash balance has an operating surplus of \$392.6 million. This is the result of a \$749.8 million beginning cash balance on July 1, 2018 and a \$357.2million operating cash deficit for FY 2019.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2019.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$240.4 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance was \$2,465.5 million.

As required by Executive Order 21 approved on June 30, 2018, §1(d), for reporting and budget planning purposes only, \$177.2 million of the General Fund is allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund.
