## **OVERVIEW**

## GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

As of June 30, 2020, the General Fund cash balance has ending net operating cash of \$833.1 million. This is the result of a \$947.5 million beginning cash balance on July 1, 2019, a \$11.9 million operating cash surplus for FY 2020 and a transfer of \$126.3 million to the Budget Stabilization Fund.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2020.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$252.4 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance was \$4,052.2 million. Of this amount, \$854.7 million is from the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) and included in the Special Fund Cash Balance. Unaudited COVID expenditures through June 30, 2020 are \$77.4 million recorded in the Special Fund. Of the \$77.4 million, \$4.9 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing. Unaudited COVID expenditures decreased from the May 31, 2020 monthly report as some expenditures were reallocated to other available State or Federal Funds.

As required by Executive Order 21 approved on June 30, 2018, §1(d), for reporting and budget planning purposes only, \$18.2 million of the General Fund was allocable to the Budget Stabilization Fund (BSF) through the June DEFAC meeting. Effective July 1, 2020 per 82 Del Law c 243 (SB 260, § 32 amending SB 240, § 74), \$63.2 million of the existing \$126.3 million Budget Stabilization Fund balance was appropriated for use in FY 2021. The balance of the Budget Stabilization Fund as of July 1, 2020 is \$63.1 million allocated to a special fund holding account that would require an act of the General Assembly to enable appropriation and spending authority.
