OVERVIEW

GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

As of July 31, 2023, the General Fund cash balance has ending net operating cash of \$2,447.4 million. This is the result of a \$3,039.5 million beginning cash balance on July 1, 2023, a \$182.0 million operating cash deficit for FY 2024 and an allocation of \$410.1 million to the Budget Stabilization Fund.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2024.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$328.8 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance was \$6,982.3 million. Of this amount, \$597.0 million was received from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) and is included in the Special Fund Cash Balance. Unaudited ARP expenditures through July 31, 2023 are \$350.4 million recorded in the Special Fund. Of the \$350.4 million, \$18.1 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing.

Effective July 1, 2023 and pursuant to 84 Del. Laws, c.81 (HB 195, §65), \$410.1 million was allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund, a special fund holding account that would require an act of the General Assembly to enable appropriation and spending authority.
