#### **OVERVIEW**

## **GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE**

As of August 31, 2018, the General Fund cash balance has an operating surplus of \$468.8 million. This is the result of a \$749.8 million beginning cash balance on July 1, 2018 and a \$281.0 million operating cash deficit for FY 2019.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2019.
