## **OVERVIEW**

## **GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE**

As of December 31, 2024, the General Fund cash balance has ending net operating cash of \$1.594 billion. This is the result of a \$3.156 billion beginning cash balance on July 1, 2024, a \$1,093.6 million operating cash deficit for FY 2025 and an allocation of \$469.2 million to the Budget Stabilization Fund.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2025.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$348.7 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance is \$6.592 billion. Of this amount, \$384.7 million from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) is included in the Special Fund Cash Balance. Unaudited ARPA expenditures through November 30, 2024, are \$650.2 million recorded in the Special Fund. Of the \$650.2 million, \$63.3 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing.

As set forth in 29 Del. Code, §6533 (k), as of July 1, 2024, \$469.2 million was allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund, a special fund reserve account requiring an act of the General Assembly to subtract funds and enable appropriation and spending authority.
