#### **OVERVIEW**

#### GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

As of August 31, 2025, the General Fund cash balance has ending net operating cash of \$2.323 billion. This is the result of a \$2.925 billion beginning cash balance on July 1, 2025, a \$132.8 million operating cash deficit for FY 2026 and an allocation of \$469.3 million to the Budget Stabilization Fund.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2026.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$366.5 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance is \$6.763 billion. Of this amount, \$249.5 million from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) is included in the Special Fund Cash Balance. Unaudited ARPA expenditures through August 31, 2025, are \$744.5 million recorded in the Special Fund. Of the \$744.5 million, \$9.9 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing.

Effective July 1, 2025, as set forth in 29 Del. Code, §6533(k), \$469.3 million was allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund, a special fund holding account that would require an act of the General Assembly to enable appropriation and spending authority.
