## OVERVIEW

### GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

As of July 31, 2026, the General Fund cash balance has ending net operating cash of \$2.197 billion. This is the result of a \$2.823 billion beginning cash balance on July 1, 2026, a \$155.1 million operating cash deficit for FY 2027 and an allocation of \$471.8 million to the Budget Stabilization Fund.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2027.

As required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6. (d), \$392.1 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance is \$7.716 billion. Of this amount, \$167.1 million from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) is included in the Special Fund Cash Balance. ARPA expenditures through July 31, 2026, are \$867.0 million recorded in the Special Fund. Of the \$867.0 million, \$39.4 million represents a temporary interfund borrowing.

Effective July 1, 2026, as set forth in 29 Del. Code, §6533(k), \$471.8 million was allocated to the Budget Stabilization Fund, a special fund holding account that would require an act of the General Assembly to enable appropriation and spending authority.
