OVERVIEW

GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

The General Fund had a fiscal year to date operating deficit of \$631.1 million and a negative cash balance of \$66.4 million with no outstanding short-term general obligation debt as of January 31, 2013.

The net operating cash balance of (\$66.4) million results from a beginning cash balance of \$564.7 million on January 31, 2013, less a \$631.1 million operating cash deficit for FY 2013.

\$198.9 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund as required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6.(d).

It should be noted that the difference between the \$198.9 million and the net operating cash balance of (\$66.4) million represents a temporary interfund borrowing of \$265.3 million, pursuant to § 7404 (d), Title 29 Delaware Code.

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance was \$1,749.5 million.
