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### **OVERVIEW**

# **GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE**

The General Fund had a cumulative operating surplus and cash balance of \$618.5 million with no outstanding short-term general obligation debt as of May 31, 2011.

The net operating cash balance of \$618.5 million results from a beginning cash balance of \$537.1 million on July 1, 2010, plus an \$81.4 million operating cash surplus for FY 2011.

\$186.4 million was dedicated to the Budget Reserve Account of the General Fund as required by the Constitution of the State of Delaware, Article VIII, § 6.(d).

The combined General Fund/Special Fund Cash Balance was \$2,048.2 million.
