OVERVIEW

GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE

As of July 31, 2017, the General Fund cash balance has an operating cash balance of \$280.4 million. This is the result from a beginning cash balance of \$474.9 million on July 1, 2017, less a \$194.5 million operating cash deficit for FY 2018.

There is no outstanding short-term general obligation debt for the fiscal year 2018.
